INDUSTRY LETTER NO. 2005-04

TO: All Licensees, Junket Representatives, Enrolled Attorneys and Interested Parties

RE: Junket Representative Permit Process

JUNKET REPRESENTATIVE APPLICATION PROCESS

No person may operate as a Junket Representative in the State of Mississippi without a current Junket Representative Permit. The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) has changed the procedure for individuals who intend to obtain a Junket Representative Permit. Listed below is the new process for obtaining a Junket Representative Permit:

1. A **completed** application for a Junket Representative Permit or renewal of a Junket Representative Permit must be submitted to the Investigations Division of the MGC along with the following:
 - a) a **non refundable** permit fee of \$500.00;
 - b) a **non refundable** investigative fee of \$500.00, and
 - c) two (2) fingerprint cards (unless fingerprint cards have been submitted to the MGC within the twelve (12) months prior to the application date).
2. Upon receipt of the above, the Investigations Division will conduct an initial background investigation. If **no** areas of concern are developed, a Junket Representative Permit will be issued for a period of three (3) years upon the completion of the initial background investigation.
3. If any areas of concern are developed during the initial background investigation the applicant will be brought forward for a full finding of suitability which will require a deposit for additional investigative fees and a personal appearance before the MGC.
4. It will be the responsibility of the applicant to file with the Investigations Division for a renewal of the Junket Representative Permit ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the permit.
5. It will be necessary for all junket representatives to submit to the Commission notice of any changes in the junket representative's status, arrest, lawsuits, and /or disciplinary actions within thirty (30) days of the event.
6. All reporting requirements will remain unchanged pursuant to III. Operations (G) (3) "Required reports and record keeping."
