

INDUSTRY LETTER NO. 2009-02
August 11, 2009

TO: All Licensees, Enrolled Attorneys and Interested Parties

FROM: Larry Gregory, Executive Director 

RE: Manufacturer/Distributor Inspection/Tracking Fee

Effective August 15, 2009, the Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) will be assessing an inspection/tracking fee in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per slot machine when an approved slot machine is transferred to or from a licensed operator.

Miss. Code Ann. § 75-76-79(6) states in part that:

- 6) The executive director and his employees may inspect every gaming device which is manufactured, sold or distributed:
- (a) For use in this state, before the gaming device is put into play.
 - (b) In this state for use outside this state, before the gaming device is shipped out of this state.

The notifications currently submitted to the district offices must be now submitted to the MGC laboratory for processing and billing. Upon receipt of the notification an agent of the MGC will be scheduled to inspect the slot machines and place a barcode for tracking purposes on the slot machines.
