NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS

Multi-Jurisdictional Personal History Disclosure Form

The **Multi-Jurisdictional Personal History Disclosure Form ("MJPHDF")** has been developed by the International Association of Gaming Regulators to standardize the personal application for a gaming license or finding of suitability. All persons applying for a Mississippi finding of suitability are required to complete this form, along with certain portions of the **Mississippi Addendum.** Both forms can be found on the Mississippi Gaming Commission website, <u>www.msgamingcommission.com</u>.

Mississippi Addendum

The **Mississippi Addendum** is also for corporate entities required to be registered or found suitable by the Mississippi Gaming Commission. Questions regarding whether a particular company is required to complete this form may be directed to the Corporate Securities section of the Mississippi Gaming Commission.

Forms 3006, 3007, 3008, as well as the "Licensee Certification" of the **Mississippi Addendum** are personal release forms that must accompany the **MJPHDF** as part of a finding of suitability application.

See the Mississippi Addendum for instructions specific to each form.

Finding of Suitability Renewal Applications

Renewal applications consist of the same documents and forms as initial applications.

In addition to the application fees for the above referenced applications, the applicant will also be responsible for the costs of the investigation. The Gaming Commission will provide estimates of investigative costs of the individual or entity being investigated prior to the initiation of the investigation.

Junket Representative Permits

Junket representative permit applications are available on the Mississippi Gaming Commission website, www.msgamingcommission.com. Page 2 of the **Junket Representative Permit Application** includes instructions for completing the form. The same application is used for renewals of junket representative permits. <u>The Mississippi Addendum is not required for this application</u>.
